Dr. Jonathan Canick has practiced clinical psychology and neuropsychology for over 25 years. He lectures on aging and cognition and identifies those who are cognitively compromised and incapacitated. His practice includes neuropsychological assessment, capacity evaluations, forensic evaluations/consultation and early identification of high functioning individuals with dementias. Dr. Canick also counsels individuals, couples and families coping with dementia and changing cognitive status.

Dr. Canick will discuss issues associated with the aging process and factors to be aware of when working with elderly clientele or those of any age struggling with neural and cognitive impairment.
